SUBJECT: El Tacolote Subdivision; Consideration & Approval of Subdivision

This property is located on the south side of Monte Cristo Road and on the west side of Peach Street, near the intersection of Hoehn Road and Monte Cristo Road. It is located outside the McAllen City Limits, but within the City's ETJ and MPU's Wastewater CCN. The tract consists of 2.174 acres and is being proposed for 1 lot to be residential and the other commercial.

The subdivision application was originally filed with the City on May 14, 2024 and has received preliminary P&Z approval on August 20, 2024. The information required from the developer's engineer for this agenda was received on March 3, 2025.

Utility plan/availability is described as follows:

- 1. **Water Service:** The property falls within the Sharyland Water Supply Corporation water CCN. The applicant will be asked to comply with the typical City of McAllen subdivision requirements as they pertain to fire protection.
- 2. **Wastewater Service:** The applicant will utilize an existing sewer service for one of the lots that is connected to the main wastewater line along Russet Street. Staff recommends that both lots have individual wastewater services.
- 3. This property falls within the MPU Hoehn Lift Station Wastewater Service Area.

Staff recommends MPUB approval of the subdivision application as proposed subject to the following:

1.) Dedication of a utility easement possibly along the perimeter of the property, and where the main utility lines are being proposed;

2.) Installation of the proposed public utility infrastructure be constructed as proposed;

3.) Execution of a Waterline Access Agreement between the developer, Sharyland Water Supply Corporation, and the City; and 4.) Payment of a Sewer Line Reimbursement to MPU in the amount of \$1,389.88 for the Hoehn Lift Station Project.

UTILITY NARRATIVE EL TACOLOTE SUBDIVISION CITY OF MCALLEN

El Tacolote is a subdivision that will consist of 1 residential lot (Lot 1) & 1 commercial lot (Lot 2), subdivision located within the ETJ City of Edinburg. Being a 2.004 acre tract out of Lot "A" Hoehn Drive Subdivision, as per map or plat recorded in Volume 23, Page 59, Map Records Hidalgo County, Texas.

WATER AND FIRE PROTECTION

A review of the City's Utility Map for this area shows that these lands are located within the CCN of the Sharyland Water Supply Corporation (SWSC). There is one existing waterline, a 12-inch running on the South Right-of-way of Monte Cristo Road owned by SWSC.

One of the lots already has an existing water service connection. Therefore, only one additional water service connection will need to be installed. The developer is proposing to connect into the 12-inch water line located along South Right-of-way of Monte Cristo Road for potable water service. The proposed water system for this subdivision will connecting a water service to that 12 in waterline.

The 2 lots will have a water service connection.

SANITARY SEWER:

The subdivision already has a sewer system in place, so there will be no need to install a sewer, this sewer system is owned by the City of Mcallen.





On February 21, 2025, Competitive Sealed Proposals were received for the McAllen North WTP Groundwater Test Drilling Project. The project involves the construction of four (4) Groundwater Test Wells at our North WTP. The Test Wells will be used to collect soils and groundwater data that will be used to design permanent production wells. Data collected will also be used to help Consultant Team fine tune design assumptions for the desalination process facility.

A single proposal was received by Hydro Resources – Mid Continent Inc., out of Creedmor, TX. The Proposal included a Base Bid for the amount of \$2,397,344. The Proposal also include a unit price fee schedule for any additions or deletions that might be encountered during drilling operations.

The proposal was evaluated by Consultant Team and ranked in accordance with scoring criteria. A copy of Recommendation Letter from Consulting Team is attached.

Staff recommends award of Contract to Hydro Resources – Mid Continental, Inc. for the Base Bid amount of \$2,397,344.

Sewer Extension (Alliance) Wastewater Improvements

The group of developers (The Alliance) is requesting a Preliminary Reimbursement Certificate for the proposed wastewater improvements to be done. Multiple subdivisions will utilize the proposed wastewater line that will be installed with the project.

The subject wastewater improvements consist of extending a 12-inch wastewater line approximately 3,974 LF, as well as 1,415 LF of 8-inch wastewater line, multiple manholes and a lift station.

The developer has proposed to establish a preliminary reimbursement service area totaling approximately 247.8 acres, which includes the area north of 6 Mile from Stewart Road to Mayberry Road.

The cost for the wastewater improvements is estimated to be approximately \$1,762,479.61.



The property falls within the SWSC Water CCN, which will be providing water to the property. Currently the property falls within MPU's Sewer CCN. The applicant is requesting a variance to install a septic tank to service the future lot as there are no MPU lines available nearby. The nearest sewer line is located approximately 1,300 feet away from the property. A layout has been submitted by a certified Sanitarian. Staff recommends MPU Board approval of the septic tank variance request, subject to coordination with Hidalgo County on the installation of the septic tank; installation of prepared sewer services; and execution of a contractual agreement for future utilities.








DEVAN ESTATES LOT 3 SEPTIC TANK VARIANCE
