SUBJECT: Approval of La Lomita Paradise Subdivision

This property is located approximately 300LF west of La Lomita Rd. and on the north side of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ Mile Rd. It is located within the McAllen City Limits and is being proposed as R-2 Residential. The tract consists of 10 acres and will consist of 42 multi-family lots.

The subdivision application was originally filed with the City on March 27, 2024 and has received preliminary P&Z approval on April 16, 2024. The information required from the developer's engineer for this agenda was received on May 6, 2024.

Utility plan/availability is described as follows:

- 1. **Water Service:** The City of McAllen has an existing 8" water line located on the south side of Brazos Avenue running east and west located north of the proposed subdivision. The subdivision will be served by an internal 8" water distribution system. The proposed 8" line will be looped to the 8" water line located at the southeast corner of La Lomita Road (proposed by another developer) and the existing 8" line located at the south side of Brazos Avenue. A stub out will be installed on the southwest corner of the subdivision for future connections. All lots will be provided with 1" water services for future multi-family duplexes and one (1) irrigation water service. Three (3) fire hydrants will be installed for fire protection within the proposed subdivision
- 2. **Sewer Service:** The City of McAllen has an existing 8" sanitary sewer line on the south side of Brazos Avenue. A proposed 8" sewer line will be connected to the existing 8" line and extended south to service the subdivision.

Staff recommends MPUB approval of the subdivision application as proposed subject to the following:

- 1.) Dedication of a utility easement, possibly along the perimeter of the property.
- 2.) Installation of the proposed public utility infrastructure to be constructed as proposed.

Staff will be available for further discussion/questions at the MPUB meeting.

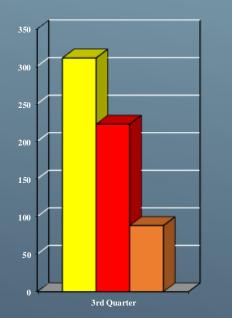

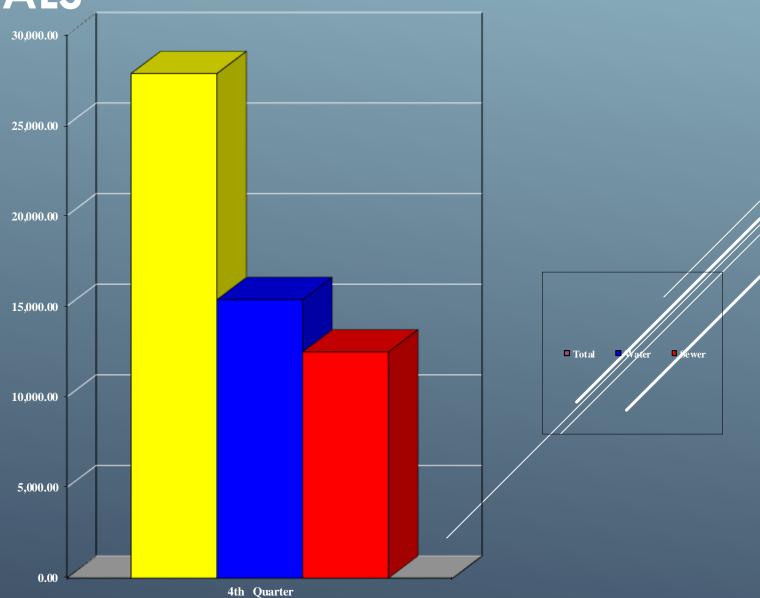

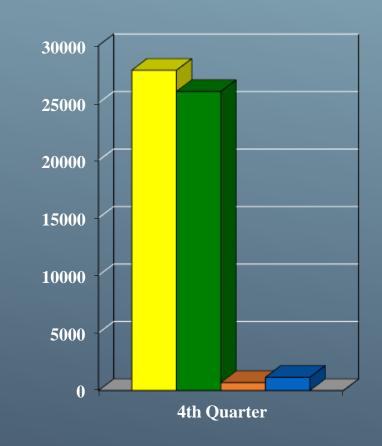

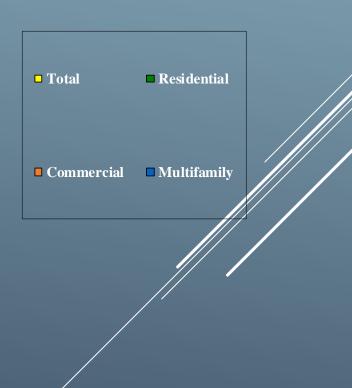

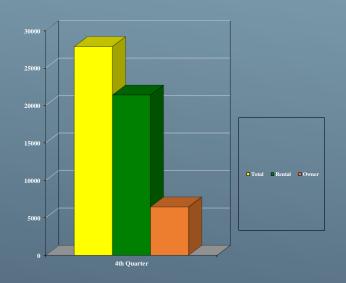

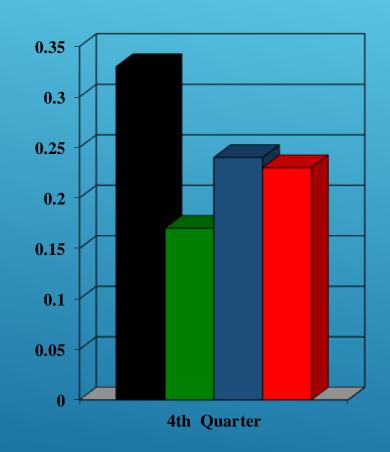

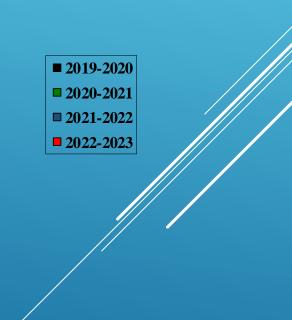

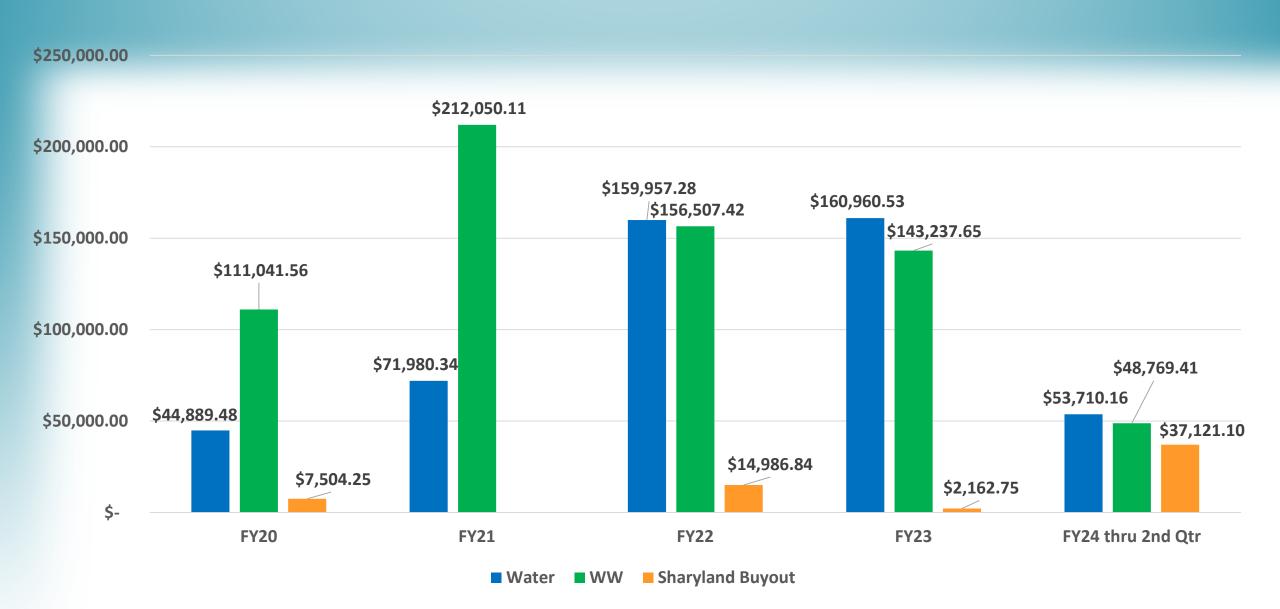
